BRUSH, LEAVES, AND YARD WASTE PICK UP

PICK UP WILL BEGIN MAY 1 AND END NOVEMBER 1

Must not exceed 10 feet in length, Must not exceed 10 inches in diameter, Must be in brown paper bags, Must be in the road right-of-way(between sidewalk and street) Must be away from mailboxes, poles, road signs and guide wires, Must not include loose leaves, trash, building materials, dirt, etc. Complete tree removals from private properties will **not** be removed by the Village. **Leaves must be bagged or in a manageable container. Bags must only contain leaves and/or yard and garden vegetation. Leaves must not be blown, raked, or placed into or on Village streets.**

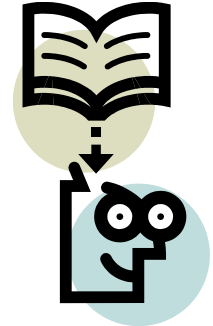
